JOKARI – NEW GENERATION CABLE STRIPPING SOLUTIONS

Under the motto "The Best. Re-invented" JOKARI is launching a new cable knife generation: the system 4-70. Different types of cables can be stripped with just one tool. This is made possible by the unique cable bracket system. Safe working is ensured by a new blade protection mechanism. Stripping is visible through an opening in the metal bracket. Developed by professionals for professionals, this new product combines safety, ergonomics, comfort and design.

For five decades, JOKARI has been a byword for quality and is the tool of choice for electrical installation. With the system 4-70, the company based in Ascheberg, has revolutionised the tried and tested basic model. Cables from 4 to 70 mm in diameter can be stripped quickly and easily with the unique cable bracket system.

Maximum safety

For daily use in trade and industry, maximum safety is essential. JOKARI has taken this into account with the newly developed blade protection mechanism. It securely covers the hooked blade at the end of the cable knife. The protection mechanism must be moved back for slitting cable sheaths with the hooked blade. Only then is the blade released. There are four cutting depth settings, depending on the cable sheath thickness. "The interchangeable, titanium-nitride coated hooked blade is




designed for maximum safety," says JOKARI Managing Director Carsten Bünnigmann.

Designed for ease of use

For the product developers of the cable knife system 4-70, the main emphasis was on ease of use: the new JOKARI is designed for a secure grip and fits snugly in the hand. Carsten Bünnigmann: "The perfect arrangement of the soft gripping zones and shape of the handle allows maximum manual force to be exerted while using the hooked blade." Stripping is visible through a small opening in the metal bracket – an important criterion for the further process. The inner blade cutting depth can be adjusted via an adjustment screw. For recurring cable sheath thicknesses, additional screw markings serve for orientation. The inner blade is interchangeable and comes a spare blade stored inside the handle of the new JOKARI.

Modular system

The basic model is supplied with the standard bracket size (8-28 mm Ø). Available options are 4-16 mm Ø, 27-35 mm Ø, 35-50 mm Ø and 50-70 mm Ø. The bracket can be changed via a "push" window in the tool: this releases the bracket for easy changing. With the system 4-70, JOKARI has developed a modular stripping tool offering maximum flexibility.

The new JOKARI cable knife system 4-70 is available from specialist retailers from spring 2016. The inner blade can subsequently be ordered as an accessory in a set of three; the hooked blade can also be ordered as a spare part.
